- 1. Professor Tony Healey presented an overview of the accomplishments, present program, and planned efforts for the Center for Autonomous Underwater Vehicle Research.**
- 2. Professor Phil Pace presented an overview of the accomplishments, present program, and planned efforts for the Center for Joint Services Electronic Warfare.**
- 3. After discussion, the Research Board recommended that both Centers be renewed for three years, having exceeded all requirements for renewal. The Dean of Research notified Professors Healey and Pace of the their Center renewals.**
- 4. After considerable discussion, the Research Board voted (1 against) not to seek a Navy patent for “Crossdock Designer” submitted by Prof. Kevin Gue.**
- 5. The current post doctoral research support program (National Research Council, American Society for Engineering Education) was discussed regarding the “1/2 funding for one year on “A” candidates from NRC or ASEE approval” policy. Also discussed was the possibility of expanding the program to permit non NRC/ASEE post-docs to be funded. The Research Board recommended that until the program funding can be increased above the current \$200K/yr NPS should continue with the very successful current program. Dean Netzer will discuss post-doc needs with the NSA Dept. for future discussions by the Research Board.**
